## Directions from Portland on I-5

Take I-5 north to exit 105 (State Capitol/City Center/Port of Olympia). Follow the Port of Olympia signs all the way around the loop, staying to the right. Go to the stop signal and turn left onto Plum Street. Stay in the City Center lane. At the third signal, turn left onto Legion Way. The Department of Personnel (600 South Franklin) is located on the left side of the street at the corner of Franklin and Legion Way. The Department of Personnel (521 Capitol Way South) is located across Capitol Way on the right side.

## Directions from Seattle on I-5

Take I-5 south to exit 105 (State Capitol/City Center/Port of Olympia). Stay to the right and exit 105-B (Port of Olympia). Stay on this road; it will turn into Plum Street. At the fourth stop signal, turn left onto Legion Way. The Department of Personnel (600 South Franklin) is located on the left side of the street at the corner of Franklin and Legion Way. The Department of Personnel (521 Capitol Way South) is located across Capitol Way on the right side.

## Directions from Highway 101

Stay in the left lane to northbound I-5. Once on I-5, take exit 105 (State Capitol/City Center/Port of Olympia). Follow the Port of Olympia signs all the way around the loop, staying to the right. Go to the stop signal and turn left onto Plum Street. Stay in the City Center lane. At the third signal, turn left onto Legion Way. The Department of Personnel (600 South Franklin) is located on the left side of the street at the corner of Franklin and Legion Way. The Department of Personnel (521 Capitol Way South) is located across Capitol Way on the right side.

## Parking

Limited parking is available in the lot behind the 600 South Franklin building. Participants can park in the spaces marked **“Visitor” 9-56 and 80-82**. There are three disabled parking spaces located directly outside the back door and two outside the front door.

***There is limited metered street parking around the 521 Capitol Way South building.***

***If you are located in Olympia, we recommend you carpool.***
